100% Real Nail Polish Nail Wrap Application Instructions

Here's how to kiss chipped nails goodbye and get a salon-quality finish with no hassle and no mess.

1. Remove existing nail polish

Make sure you do not have any lotion, oil, grease, or dirt on your nails, because this will make it difficult for the strips to adhere to your nails. Take the cleansing pad and rub it on each nail. If your set did not come with one, use a cotton ball soaked in rubbing alcohol.



4. Remove wrinkles and bubbles



Smooth the strip down, while applying pressure. Keep smoothing it until the folds and wrinkles go away. If the strip is still wrinkly, use the wood stick. Don't press too hard with the stick, the strip might rip.

2. Select a size



Choose the size that fits your nail the best. You may need to trim the strips.

Gently peel the strip away from the backing. Do not touch the sticky part any more than necessary, because the oils from your fingers will make it less sticky.

5. File the nail

Using a nail file or emery board, file the strip at the end of the nail, in a downwards motion, removing the excess wrap and smoothing the edge.



3. Position the strip on the nail

Place the strip onto your nail, positioning it as close to the cuticle as possible without overlapping.



Additional Suggestions

- Apply at room temperature
- Apply Top Coat to extend the life of the wrap. Be sure to apply it on the edge of the nail to seal the strip down.
- Use nail polish remover to remove the wraps.
- For best results, apply before bed.
